Our Café Lucero Supremo comes from the contributions of about two hundred small producers from La Celica town in the department of Risaralda. This area is located at 1,350 meters above sea level providing good elevation for coffee cultivation. As it is a Supremo, only coffees with a large 17/18 screen size have been selected for this lot.

The main harvest of this region happens from October to November, and the fly-crop in March to April. The small holders in this area typically own 6 – 15 acres and primarily grow the hybrid cultivar, Castillo. Coffees are all washed processed and sun dried by individual farmers.
