Kenya Coffee Growing Regions 



The origins of coffee in Kenya can be traced back to the 1800's when French and Scottish missionaries first brought Yemen Mocha Arabica to East Africa. The cultivation of these original seedlings over the decades, adapting to weather and disease, has resulted in a multitude of varieties, each expressing more resilience and improved quality over time. The Kenya coffee auction system, known as the Nairobi Coffee Exchange was opened in 1937 and is still critical to the industry today. Due to the government sanctioned auction system, all coffee flowing through the country is tracked making full traceable Kenya blended lots possible.
