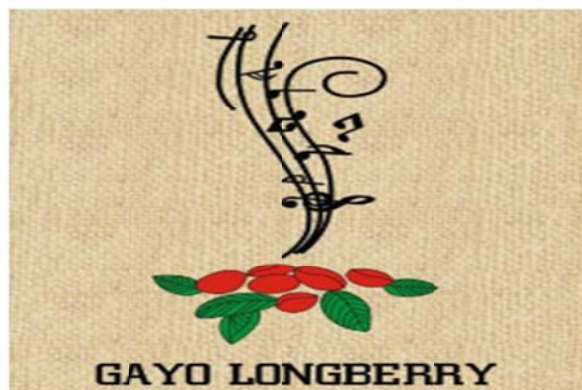

Oriza Darmawan has been a producer and processor for 10 years. He is a second generation coffee farmer and now manages 6 additional farmers in his supply chain with a total farm size of 10 Hectares. Coffee is “A Way of Life” for Mr. Darmawan and the Gayo community and a distinct and essential part of local culture.
